A meeting of the Guru Nanak College Governing Council was held today the **8th of December, 2019 at 12.30 P.M.** in the women's wing premises of the college. Sardar R. S. Chahal, President, was in the chair. The following members were present:

Proceedings:

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting dated **27th of August 2019** were read, and confirmed.
2. **Issues arising out of the previous meetings:**
 - (a) It was informed by the principal that all five teachers appointed by the Governing Council vide its resolution no. 7 dated 27th August 2019 on the recommendation of the Selection Committees have joined the college as Asst. Professors.
Also, the five teachers appointed in 2018 have been given extension for another eleven months as per resolution no. 5 of the Governing Council meeting dated 27th August 2019.
 - (b) It was informed by the principal that Ms. Nushrat Parween has joined the College as the College Librarian at Bhuda campus as per resolution no. 6 of the Governing Council meeting dated 27th August 2019 on probation for a period of one year.
3. Regarding Sri Prabhat Kumar's case it was informed by the Secretary and the Principal that the "Order" of the Vice Chancellor had been challenged by the College represented by the Secretary in Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. Also, prayer was made that the "order" of the Vice Chancellor, BBMK University, Dhanbad be stayed till a final decision is taken by the Hon'ble Court.

Sri Prabhat Kumar, who came to the College several times for joining has been denied permission to join the College till such time as the matter was pending in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand.

4. (a) It was decided to have three more lectures under the banner of “Guru Nanak Dev lecture series” during the Golden Jubilee year:

1. “Career in Defence” by Colonel Harpal Singh Grewal, Fort William Kolkata.
2. “Computer Science ” by Dr. D. Ramesh, IIT ISM, Dhanbad and
3. “Environmental issues” by Prof. Gurdip Singh Professor HAG, and Ex. V.C. , Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag.

during the months of January/February 2020.

b) It was decided to have the following two functions in the first half of February 2020 by way of conclusion of the Golden Jubilee celebrations of the college.

The two functions would be known as “Epilogue to Nostalgia”.

- (i) An open air lyrical play on “Heer Ranjha” and
- (ii) A “Music and dance evening” having songs and dances of various states and folk cultures of India.

The amount of money for the above functions was sanctioned by the Governing Council.

5. The Principal informed that the preparation for assessment and accreditation of the College for second cycle was underway. It was expected that IIQA would be sent on-line to NAAC latest by the end of April 2020; and the last (fourth) AQAR would be submitted before 15th February 2020.

The proposal for repair, construction, maintenance e.g. white-washing and colouring etc of the (a) Vocational Studies building and (b) Bhuda Building was approved and financial sanction for the same was given. The Secretary and the Principal were authorized to get things done in consultation with the President.

Also, it was decided to get two toilets constructed on both sides of the S.J.S. Grewal Auditorium – one for ladies and the other for men.

Also, it was decided to get a dining area created/constructed just opposite the Auditorium with raised platform in it covered by sheets.

Also, it was decided to make the college library a fully automated one and digital. It was decided to purchase books worth five lakhs for the Library.

It was expected that NAAC assessment for second cycle would be completed by the end of August/September 2020.

6. Miscellaneous:

- (a) It was decided to open an Account in the Allahabad Bank in the name of “ GNC Intermediate Teaching Fund” to be operated by any two of the (1) Secretary (compulsory) (2) either President and (3) or Sardar J. S. Sandhu
- (b) As the College had stopped teaching B.Ed. since 2014, it was decided to dispose off the old records of B.Ed. by burning the papers, which have occupied a big hall as storage.

There being no other matter to discuss, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
