Proceedings:-

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.
2. Criterion 4 deals with infrastructure and learning resource. The college is having two campuses, Bhuda Campus , Women's wing at Bankmore and and the third one i;e Doves.In all campuses adequate infrastructural facility are available. In BhudaCampus twelve small and big size classrooms and two ICT classrooms with LCD are their.On the other hand, in Women's wing fifteen classrooms and two ICT enabled rooms with LCD are their. DOVS is having six classrooms. All campuses are equipped with Wifi, and VC in DOVS. Spart from this college is having two seminar halls one each in Bhuda and Bankmore Campus. Auditorium and Meeting room have been constructed in recent past in the Bhuda Campus of college. Gym is functional at Bankmore Campus.
3. The college is having eighty systems (computers) for teaching purpose, two computer labs of 30 systems each in the DOVS and one laboratory of 20 systems in the Bhuda Campus. Library and Reading room facility, in both campuses is available. There is a dispensary named Bhai kanhaiya dispensary for the students of women's wing of the college.
4. Adequate facilities for sports, games and cultural activities are available in Bhuda Campus of college. Auditorium with seating arrangement of 400 persons in the Bhuda Campus is an added advantage for the students of the College.
5. The college doesn't have a playground, however we do have volleyball court and practice pitch for cricket and a Badminton court for practice in the courtyard. Students of the college do have the facility of TT, chess and carrom.
6. Yoga classes are held in Auditorium on a regular basis. All Cultural activities and functions are organized in the Auditorium, even practice sessions are held in the Auditorium. First Inter college youth festival of

newly established BBMK university was organized in the Auditorium of the college.

7. The college Library has been developed as a resource centre with the facilities of INFLIBNET, ILMS, KOHA, OPAC. Altogether 17000 volume of books with automation are available in the library.
8. The college is having a good IT infrastructural facility in all three campuses. There is Internet facility of 40 mbps in the Women's wing which covers DOVS also. On the other hand internet facility with 20 mbps speed is available at Bhuda Campus.
9. It would not be out of context to mention that college was given the facility of 10 BB - VPN with 2 mbps in the year 2008.
10. In 2016 the FOSS centre was inaugurated. The college has the distinction of having first such centre with spoken tutorial programme- MOOCS monitored by IIT Bombay.
11. More than 1000 students have successfully completed various programmes of spoken Tutorial with certificate of Excellence.
12. Criterion 5 deals with students support and progression. A very important aspect of students representation on various bodies came for discussion. The Principal apprised faculty members that students union in the college was active till July 2017. The last students union election was held in November 2016 to elect the office bearers i.e President, Vice President, General Secretary, Joint Secretary. NCC of our college is very active with one group of 160 students. Two students attain the position of ANO per forty NCC cadets. Likewise, two students, a boy and a girl, are nominated to IQAC as students' representative.
13. Criterion- 6 deals with Governance Leadership and Management. Teachings of Guru Nanak is the core of our vision and mission. Also, to grow economically and socially.
14. Finally, Criterion- 7 speaks volume about the Institutional social values and Responsibilities. The principal narrated about these values. In this regards he also apprised how constitutional obligations were fulfilled. He also talked about best practices of our college, namely Guru Nanak Dev lecture series and Enrichment programme of Department of Creativity.
15. The term of the student representative of IQAC was already over. It was recommended by the teachers of the college to nominate the following two students to be members of the IQAC. This may specially recorded but the student union election had not been held by the university since 2017:
