Proceedings:-

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.
2. A meeting of staff council was convened on 2nd April 2021 to discuss the SSR of college (second cycle) submitted to NAAC.
The Principal explained the Executive Summary of SSR of the college, starting with Criterion/ Chapter 1: Vision and Mission. He happily informed the members of staff council that Vision : 2025 Document of the college was prepared and released on 3rd March 2015, keeping in view of the perspective plan for 10 years. He further said that there was no change in the vision and Mission of the college. He also discussed SWOC of the college in detail.
3. The Principal informed that Staff council meetings are held at least four times in a year for all round deliberations on various issues relating to academic and co-curricular activities.
He talked about PTMs which is organized departmentally for honest feedback from parents. In this regard he nominated two senior teachers namely, Prof Amarjeet Singh and Prof. Sanjay Kumar Sinha, in the Feedback Committee. He informed the teachers that a new feedback form was prepared for parents and students keeping in view of online teaching during pandemic.
4. Criterion 2 mainly deals with Teaching, Learning and Evaluation.
The question of students diversity came for discussion. The Principal talked about various aspects of shifting of college to Bhuda Campus and again opening up of girls wing at Bank More. He gave the answer to the question of why we shifted to Bhuda Campus. In his answer, he said that college shifted mainly because of all round development of students in their own campus.
He also, explained that girls wing was again opened at Bank More on demand from parents from society.
5. The Principal highlighted one of the most important aspects of teaching i.e. various methods. He talked about how dynamic and slow learners are identified.

6. The Principal talked about students Diversity. In this regard he informed the members of staff council that there is a transparent system of admission in our college. Out of total enrolled students about 55 percent are girls and rest boys.

There is a structured system of identifying fast and slow learners. Seminar classes, surprise tests are held on a regular basis for the purpose. Remedial classes are organized departmentally for the slow learners.

7. The Principal discussed the role and importance of IQAC at length .He said that IQAC is very active in making strategies for the purpose of overall growth and Development of the college.
8. The system of appraisal to the teachers has been introduced in the college. Every faculty member has to fill up the Self Appraisal Report periodically. As regards Resource Centre college library is equipped with INFLIBNET and Computer Laboratory does have the facility of video conferencing.
9. In our college a number of extension activities are carried out, by an active NSS and NCC. NSS wing of the college has adopted nearby village Dhokra, where special camps are organized to have awareness in the village community. Likewise, NCC also plays an important role in the field of social service, for example Blood Donation, Swachta Abhiyan etc. The Rotaract Club of Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad came into existent in the year 2014 with the main motive of service for community and Empathy for underprivileged.
10. The Principal happily informed the members present that during the last five years there has been an addition in the administrative block of the college. A full fledged Auditorium with a capacity of around 300 seating arrangement has been constructed ,S J S Grewal Auditorium. Because of the infrastructural facilities focus has been shifted to Bhuda Campus .
11. In Bhuda Campus a new computer Laboratory with 20 systems has come up. Library in the main Campus has been toned up in a wonderful manner with more number of books on various subjects and magazines. Reading room adjacent to library is going to be an added advantage to our students.
