PROCEEDINGS:

The proceedings of the previous meeting were read by the Coordinator, Dr. Ranjana Das. After which the meeting started with a welcome note by the Principal, Dr. Sanjay Prasad.

Issues arising out, and action taken Report

It was noted that the meeting of IQAC could not be called after the result received from NAAC, as it was decided to go for appeal, noticing a marked difference between the reports of NAAC Peer team and the DVV team. This meeting could be finally called after receiving a confirmation email from NAAC accepting our appeal for review of NAAC Results.

Principal Dr. Sanjay Prasad brought into notice the action taken in view of the previous meeting and informed about the successful organization of 4th Guru Nanak Dev online lecture on National Education Policy, in which Prof. Ramesh Sharan was invited as the Chief Speaker.

He further read aloud the NAAC Peer team report of the 2nd cycle and the members found the Peer -team report as positive and satisfactory. However, it was noted that some sections of the DVV need strict revaluation.

Thereafter, Prof. P. Shekhar made point by point analysis of the Assessment Outcome Document. It was found that Criterion 1, Criterion 3 and Criterion 5 needed major review on part of NAAC. According to the Peer-team report the grade was 3.2 (almost 83% marks), however, the DVV report graded us 2.02(50% marks) which showed a marked difference and a matter of great concern.

He further mentioned that the Perspective Plan of the Institution will also need some changes and additions, keeping in view the NAAC recommendations.

The strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges were laid down and the recommendations provided by NAAC Peer team were also discussed with the members of the Cell. It was noted that a canteen would be developed in the College campus at the earliest.

Prof P. Shekhar questioned the reason behind the non-functioning of NSQF Add-on courses for a long time, to which the Principal provided the details of the course being under final confirmation from the University Academic Council. It was suggested by Prof. Shekhar to resume the NSQF Add-on Courses for students in face-to-face mode without any further delay.

From here, the next agenda of the meeting was taken up and the Institutional Development Plan (to be submitted to RUSA) was discussed. It was informed that the plan is being made keeping in view the requirements of the National Education Policy -2020.

Thereafter, the members were informed about the Guru Nanak Dev Online Lecture to be organized by the Department of History on 26th December, 2021.

There being no other issue to discuss, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
