

Imbibing Tagore | 9th May, 2022
A Distinguished Talk by Prof. Sanjukta Dasgupta *on*
“A Patriot: Not a Nationalist? Rabindranath Tagore and the Idea of India”
Organised by Department of English, Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad

A special talk on “Imbibing Tagore” was organized by the Department of English, Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad on the occasion of Rabindranath Tagore’s birth anniversary. The theme of the lecture was “A Patriot: Not a Nationalist? Rabindranath Tagore and the Idea of India”, in which Prof. Sanjukta Dasgupta was addressing the audience as the distinguished speaker. Dr Dasgupta is a well-known litterateur, critic, translator and poet of the country, besides being a distinguished member of the General Council and Advisory Board of the Sahitya Akademi.

Beginning her address, Prof. Sanjukta referred to Rabindranath's poem "The Sunset of the Century" which was published in 1899. She subtly established Tagore as a poet, as a noted intellectual and as a writer, and then discussed the difference between nationalism and patriotism. Presenting the nationalism and patriotism views of German philosopher Herder, Jürgen Habermas and K A Appiah, Prof. Dasgupta reached out to Tagore's point of view and pointed out the ill effects displayed by him. Rabindranath Tagore had an unwavering belief in universalism, due to which he also returned the knighthood. Prof Dasgupta said that Tagore always opposed the political concepts of nationalism and patriotism, due to which his ideas kept clashing with Gandhi. Referring many of Tagore's works, Prof Sanjukta finally established that Tagore was neither a nationalist nor a patriot – but a poet, pioneer of humanity and a warrior fighting all kinds of fear.



Prof Debjani Biswas, Dean Students Welfare of BBMK University also discussed Tagore's life and writings while addressing the speakers. During the program an interactive session was also conducted in which students asked some questions to the speaker. The event ended with the vote of thanks by the Head of the department, Prof. Amarjit Singh. The program was conceptualized and coordinated by Dr. Varsha Singh.
