The International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB)” was celebrated in Guru Nanak college, Dhanbad on 22nd may 2022. The event was organized under the joint aegis of Nature Club. To mark the occasion, an online talk was organised by the college and the topic of discussion was “Biological diversity and its management”. The key speaker of the event was Dr. Kashmir Singh, Professor & Chairperson, Department of Biotechnology and Coordinator DST, Centre for Policy Research, Punjab University, Chandigarh.

The event started with the opening address by Prof Pushpa Tewari Co-coordinator, BCA and in her discourse, she introduced the topic of the webinar. After this the principal of the college Dr. Sanjay Prasad delivered the welcome address and, in his address, he introduced the attendees to the key speaker of the programme Dr. Kashmir Singh.

Dr. Kashmir Singh then delivered his talk on the topic through power point presentation. He discussed about the need of understanding and awareness of biodiversity issues.

Through his presentation he conferred the important ways to increase the methods of betterment of nature and shared various information on biodiversity, its importance, need for its conservation and sustainable use of its components.

He explained that Biodiversity is the living fabric of our planet. It underpins human wellbeing in the present and in the future, and its rapid decline threatens nature and people alike.

He further said how the main global drivers of biodiversity loss are climate change, invasive species, over-exploitation of natural resources, pollution and urbanization. After his talk, the interactive session came in action in which the students asked several queries from the resource person and Dr Singh spoke on all of them ideally.


The next address of the event was from Mr A K Sahay, Founder and convener Indian Birds Photography Society (IBPS), Dhanbad. He precisely spoke about the importance of healthy nature for the existence of birds and also the importance of birds for the existence of nature and so for humans.

The discussion was summed up by President of the College Governing Council, Sardar R S Chahal. He, in his dialogue, mentioned that it is the need of the hour that we all collaboratively work towards the conservation of biodiversity.

The event marked its end with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr Meena Malkhandi, HOD Dept. of Political Science.

The event was attended by around 120 students of the college. 
