He has been also selected as an Assistant Professor at Babasahab Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Muzaffarpur through BPSC. He has completed his M.A., M.Phil. and Ph.D. from Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. He has been awarded Gold Medal for securing the highest marks in his postgraduation. He has got SRF (UGC) for his doctoral work. He teaches courses related to Historiography, Indian National Movement, Contemporary India, Socio-Cultural and Intellectual History of Modern India, etc. at the postgraduation level. He has been part of the Board of Studies, Department of Historical Studies and Archaeology, CUSB, Gaya which revised the MA and PhD Programme syllabus as per the recommendations of NEP-2020. He has several publications to his credit. He has participated and presented papers in more than 20 National and International seminars.

An online lecture was organized by the History Department of Guru Nanak College on Saturday, December 23, 2023 on the topic: “Impact of Partition of India and the Question of Nation Building” from 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM at the Bank More campus of the college.

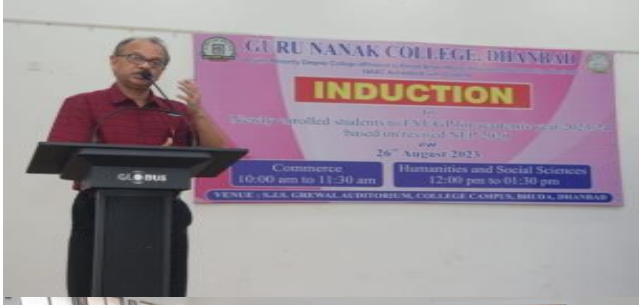
Name of the Event – Induction Programme of Session 2023-27 under FYUGP
