A meeting of the IQAC was initiated on 4th January, 2023, 12:30 pm onwards in the IQAC Room

of Bank More Campus.

PROCEEDINGS:

The meeting began with a welcome note by the Principal, Dr. Sanjay Prasad. Thereafter,

proceedings of the previous meeting were read by the Coordinator, Dr. Ranjana Das.

It was informed that the Viva Exam of NSQF Add-on courses would be scheduled at earliest. It

was also intimated that the classes of BBA have begun with ten admitted students (due to late

admissions). The Principal informed that communication regarding insurance of students is still

undergoing. Proposals have arrived (from Bajaj Allianz, Oriental) which are yet to be negotiated.

with all revisions was presented and discussed. It was also informed that the latest AQAR has

been uploaded on the College website.

Thereafter, details of NEP syllabus were discussed. It was informed that the NEP Syllabus is still under scanned from the level of University.

The cell was informed that the classes and departmental plans are being executed without many disruptions. It was also brought to light that the execution reports are continuously evaluated through Staff Council Meetings.

A suggestion was made to think about providing scholarships/freeships to deserving students.

A demand was made by the IQAC Coordinator regarding the development of infrastructure, keeping in mind the onset of new programmes in the College. A plan was initiated to build six new rooms in the Vocational Block of the College.

The members of the cell were informed that call for submissions has been initiated for the next issue of Annual College Magazine: Baisakhi to be launched on 16th April, 2023.

The IQAC Coordinator proposed to plan a workshop on Research Methodology (in response to the structure of NEP regarding the enhancement of research).
