"Viksit Bharat @ 2047: Through the Lenses of Union Budget 2024-25"

An open discussion on "Viksit Bharat @ 2047: Through the Lenses of Union Budget 2024-25" was organized by the Department of Economics & Commerce, focusing on how the Union Budget 2024-25 supports India's long-term goal of becoming a developed nation by 2047. The event featured analyses from different professors, offering insights into the budget's impact on critical sectors that will drive this transformation.

Dr. Sanjay Prasad opened the event with a comprehensive overview of the Union Budget, highlighting its key fiscal measures and how they align with India's developmental trajectory by focusing on the critical areas like Employment, Skilling, MSMEs, Middle Class. Prof. Sadhna Kumari Singh followed with a detailed exploration of the key statistics of the budget, emphasizing the budget's focus on four themes i.e, Garib, Yuva, Ananddata & Nari. These sectors are viewed as the backbone of economic growth, essential for achieving the Viksit Bharat vision.

Ms. Saloni Khandelwal shed light on the pillars identified in the budget for Viksit Bharat 2047, which include economic resilience, inclusive growth, and sustainable development. Talk by Prof. Ekta Srivastava delved into the agriculture sector, discussing how budgetary measures are set to boost productivity, enhance resilience against climate challenges, and stabilize the rural economy, which is vital for inclusive growth.

The impact of the budget on individual taxpayers was analyzed by Prof. Piyush Agarwal, who discussed tax reforms aimed at increasing disposable income, compliance. Prof. Daljeet Singh's session focused on employment and skilling initiatives, which are designed to equip India's youth with the necessary skills to thrive in a rapidly changing job market, with programs like internships and vocational training receiving significant budgetary support, while Prof. Sapna Gupta discussed the budget's substantial investments in infrastructure and tourism, which are crucial for economic expansion and job creation. Finally, Prof. Santosh Kumar's session

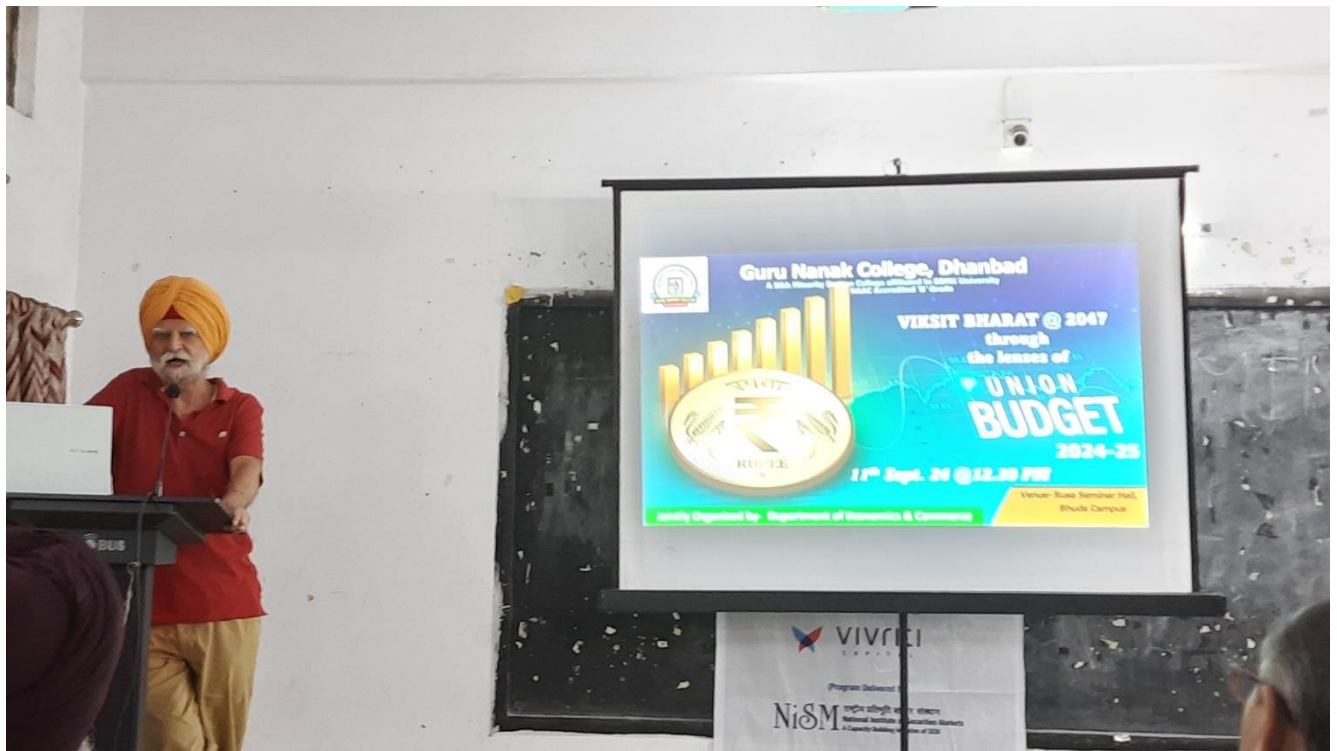
outlined the summary on the government's plans to bolster digital ecosystems, enhancing e-governance, energy transformation, Infrastructure Development.
