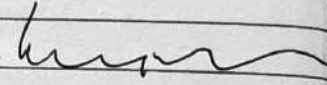
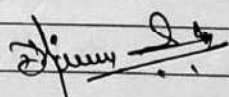
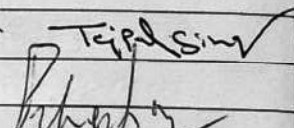
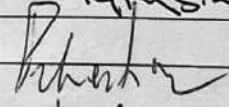
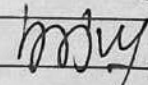
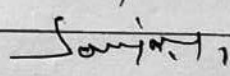


A meeting of the Guru Nanak College governing council was held today, Monday 3rd June 2024 in the women's wing premises of the college at 12:30 pm. Sarda A.S. Chahal, President of the college was in the chair. The following members were present:

Proceedings:

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting dated 23/12/2023 were read and confirmed.
2. The Principal apprised the members of the college governing council that finishing work is still going on on the third floor of the department of Vocational Studies building. The parapet work on the roof top has been completed; however the plaster work of the parapet from the inside, electrification, wiring and inside painting are still to be completed.

3. The Principal informed the members of the governing council about the development of the labour court case filed by the five retired non-teaching staff of our college for non-payment of gratuity, pension etc. Smt. Preeti Mandal, a lawyer appointed by the college, has advised to file a supplementary rejoinder in the court of Dy. Labour Commissioner Bikaner. The governing council has asked the Secretary and the Principal to keep an eye on this matter.

4. The Principal informed the members that AICTE has given the approval to our two vocational courses for the academic session 2024-25 - a new directive from the AICTE. The college has got the letter of approval (LOA) from the All India Council of Technical Education. He also apprised that our college is first in the University to get the approval for the courses from AICTE. The members expressed happiness on this development.

5. The Principal informed that after pay fixation five non-teaching staff of our college have started getting their salary from the government University with effect from February 2024. Their names are as follows:-

The members expressed happiness on this development.

6. It was informed by the Principal that in view of the requirements of AICTE, a few rooms in the department of Vocational Studies and B.Ed. block needed to be renovated. The proposal of the principal was approved, and it was decided to get the work completed and the work order be given to the Contractor, M. D. Zahir. Also, the Secretary and the Principal were authorised to supervise the same.

7. The Principal informed the governing Council that the Sanction letter - for the grant-in-aid of Rs. 200000/- from ICSSR for organising the National Seminar on G 20 - A Global Platform for Economic Development - had been received by the college on 26/04/2024.

The Sanctioned amount will be released in two installments:-
 First installment - Rs. 1,50,000/-
 Second installment - Rs. 50,000/-

Members present expressed happiness on this matter.

8. It was informed by the Secretary and the principal that Sri. Chiranjit Adhikari, Assistant Professor in the department of Commerce, had resigned from his position and submitted a letter of resignation on 16th January 2024. It was also informed that this development had been communicated to the District and Public Service Commission, Raichur, for records.

9. It was informed by the Principal that Sri. Ajit Kumar Singh, former Librarian of our college, has filed a case against the State of Jharkhand through the higher, technical and skill development department of the government of Jharkhand and Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag for the grant of pay scale/salary of a Lecturer. In this regard, we received a notice from Dr. Ashok K. Singh, Ex-chief Secretary of Jharkhand and advocate, High Court of Jharkhand, Ranchi, on 26/01/2024 by post. Through this notice we have come to know that the governing council, through Secretary/Principal, Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad, is one of the respondents. As advised by the advocate Dr. Ashok K. Singh, we have sent him the required details.

10. The Principal proposed to have a new construction of 5000 square feet on the second floor of the Bhuda campus of the college towards the eastern part of the main building. This proposal was approved subject to the availability of funds.

11. The President, Sardar A. S. Chahal, asked the Secretary and the Principal to look into the feasibility of extending the capacity of SRS Auditorium by 2000 square feet to expand the capacity of the auditorium. In this regard, it was decided to consult the architect Engineer Mr. Piyush Kanti Singh.

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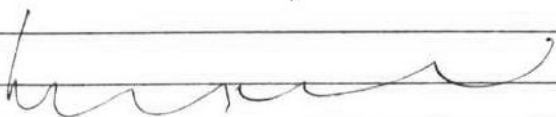
Misc.

It was informed by the Principal that the boundary wall towards the north of the Bheda campus of the College adjacent to the road that leads to the 'Bheda Basti' has tilted and requires immediate attention. Also, it was pointed out that a small room constructed on the north side of the main campus is now in a dilapidated condition. In view of the safety of the campus, it was resolved to demolish the room, erect a new guard, and a new boundary wall to be constructed after demolishing the old one. The Secretary and the Principal were authorised to supervise the construction.

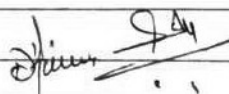
P.S.
