The Agenda and the proceedings discussed and recorded as follows:

- 1) Confirmation of the proceedings of the previous meeting:

The meeting commenced with a warm welcome to the chair and all members present. The Coordinator, IQAC read out the proceedings of the previous meeting. The House observed with satisfaction that the agenda items of the previous meeting had been taken up effectively and that the process of their implementations is progressing in a positive and satisfactory manner. The proceedings were thereafter confirmed by the Chairperson, IQAC.

- 2) Action Taken Report:

Under this agenda, the Principal, Dr. Ranjana Das apprised the House regarding the progress made on the introduction of new Vocational programmes; namely MBA, MCA, B.Lib. and Foreign Languages courses. It was informed that all necessary formalities had been duly completed and the proposals were forwarded to the university. The proposals were well received.

The House took note of the progress with appreciation.

3. To apprise and discuss the issue regarding fourth and final submission of AQAR for AY 2024-2025.

Under the agenda, the House was apprised that as per the latest notifications available on the NAAC Portal, the submission of the AQAR for the academic year - 2024-2025, at present, is not being accepted. However, it was informed that the AQAR has already been prepared in full and ready for submission.

The House was assured that the same shall be submitted promptly as soon as the portal allows submission. The members took note of the preparedness with satisfaction.

4. Review of the Draft of Vision-2030 (Five Year Perspective Plan).

Under the agenda, the Principal, Dr. Ranjana Das apprised the House that the Vision-2030 document (Five Year Perspective Plan of the institution) has been prepared. Dr. Varsha Singh presented the revised draft before the House, which was noted to be comprehensive and extensive in its scope. During the discussion, Prof. P. Shekhar, Member, Academic, Governing Body, suggested that the Vision document should further incorporate clear roadmaps leading to concrete and measurable outcomes. The House took note of the suggestion.

The President, Sardar R. S. Chahal, expressed appreciation for the draft Vision-2030. It was resolved that after incorporating the suggested improvements, the Vision document be formally approved and implemented.

5. To apprise and discuss preparations for the National Seminar on "Jharkhand @ 25: Celebrating 25 Years of Statehood and 150 Years of Jangatiya Gaurav" Sponsored by JSHEC, Govt. of Jharkhand.

Under the agenda, Prof. Sadhna Kumari Singh, Asst. Prof. Economics apprised the House of the progress made in preparation for the two-day National Seminar scheduled to be held on 6th & 7th December 2025. She presented details regarding the Chief guest, Guests of Honour and other dignitaries for the inaugural and valedictory sessions as well as the

Resource Persons invited to deliver the Key note addresses.

The Principal, Dr. Langana was informed that a comprehensive organisational structure has been put in place, with several committees constituted for smooth execution of the event, including those for stage management, reception, hospitality, catering and ~~conference~~ certificate preparation, comprising both teaching and non-teaching staff. She further stated that the institution is fully prepared for the successful conduct of the seminar.

During discussion, Prof. P. Shekhar, suggested that all sessions of the seminar be organised at a single venue, and that the programme schedule be designed keeping in view the practical convenience of the delegates. The House accepted the suggestion and assured its implementation.

6. Review of One-day Lecture programme under Gurm Nanak Dev Lecture Series on 10th September 2025.

The House reviewed the one day lecture programme organised under Gurm Nanak Dev Series by the Dept. of Hindi on 10th Sept. 2025 on the topic "गुरुगुरु के काल में लीला/पद-वैभवं". The lecture was delivered by Prof. Vijay Kumar Bharti, Professor, Gazi Nazim University, Asansol. The House observed that the lecture was highly enriching and proved to be beneficial not only for students of Hindi literature but also for students across disciplines.

A formal note of appreciation recorded in favour of Prof. Vijay Kumar Bharti for his scholarly deliberation and Prof. Soma Pt. Yadav, HOD along with the teachers of the Hindi Dept. for successfully organising the lecture.

Miscellaneous Agenda:

Under this agenda, the Principal, informed the House that the third batch of girl students of the college is set to participate in a 10 (forty) day free training programme at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad.
