A meeting of the Guru Nanak College governing council was held today Saturday 25/01/2025 in the women's wing campus of the college at 11:30 Sardar R.S Chahal President of the college was in the chair the following members were present:

Proceedings:

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting dated 3rd June 2024 were read and confirmed.
2. The Principal presented a report on the ICSSR sponsored Two-Day National Seminar on G20: A Global Platform for Economic Development, organised by the department of Economics on 20th and 21st July 2024. He informed the members of the governing council that the seminar was inaugurated by the honorable vice-chancellor of our university along with the President and the secretary of governing council of our college and resource persons who were present on the occasion. The two-day National seminar consisted of 6 technical sessions and ended with a valedictory session.

3. The Principal informed honorable members of the governing council that Higher and Technical Education -HRD Government of Jharkhand, Ranchi has granted affiliation to our ongoing BBA program for two academic sessions 2024-27 and 2025-28 and the same has been notified by Binod Bihari Mahto University Dhanbad. The members expressed happiness in this development.
4. The Principal happily informed the members of the council that in this academic year- 2024-27 admission to BBA and BCA program has reached its full capacity that is 90 admissions in each course. Every member of the council expressed happiness.
5. The college has taken initiative to apply to AICTE for approval of our two courses BCA and BBA for the academic session 2025 -26. In this regard the form filling up process was started on 4th Jan 2025. In the last week of Jan 2025, we will have to deposit Rs. 88,000/- as TER charges for two courses BCA & BBA.

6. The Principal informed the members of the Governing Council that BBMK University had given the responsibility of organizing the 5th Inter College Youth Festival “Antarnaad 2024”, to our college, which was organized by the college from 20th Dec to 22nd Dec 2024 in a grand manner. The Youth Festival 2024 was officially inaugurated by Honorable Vice-Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Ram Kumar Singh. During the three days gala events 29 competitive events were organized under the supervision of organizing committee. The Youth Festival “Antarnaad 2024” ended with the prize distribution ceremony where Honorable Vice-Chancellor and D.S.W were present.

7. The Principal placed a proposal for procurement of the following items:

- Sound System/P. A System, and
- CCTV Coverage in DOVS premises

The Secretary and The Principal were authorized to invite quotations and finalized the purchase of the above items as per AICTE Guidelines.

8. The Principal proposed enhancement of salary of Eight (08) Teachers of our college who are getting a consolidated pay/salary of Rs. 25,000/- per month. He proposed an enhancement of Rs. 6,000/- per month to all eight (08) teachers with effect from March 2025. Their names are as follows: -

The proposal of the principal was unanimously approved w.e.f march 2025.

9. The matter of enhancement of salary of two teachers and lab assistant of BCA course came up for discussion. The Principal proposed an enhancement of Rs. 8,000/- to two teachers and Rs. 6,000/- to lab assistant as per following details: -

After due consideration the proposal of the principal was approved unanimously with w.e.f March 2025.

10. The Principal placed a letter dated 26/12/2024 from Income Tax office, Exemption ward Dhanbad, reference: for payment of outstanding demand of Rs. 1,99,91,190/- under section 143 for the assessment year 2023-2024. He also informed Governing council, that the matter was immediately brought to the notice of our Honorable President and Secretary and CA Sri. K.K. Harodia. A Tripartite meeting was arranged in which Honorable President Sardar R. S. Chahal from college management Principal and Bursar from the college administration and C.A and Tax consultant Sri. K. K. Harodia and Aman Goyenka was present. It was discussed in the meeting at length and was decided to give the reply to the Income Tax Department within stimulated time period and file an appeal.

11. The Principal informed the Governing Council that Mrs. Anuradha Kumari working as Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychology has resigned from her position and submitted a letter of resignation on 04/12/2024. Her resignation letter was forwarded to the Secretary of the college to be placed in the next GB Meeting. The governing council has accepted her resignation and the Secretary was authorized to send a letter in this matter to JPSC, Ranchi for the needful.

12. The Principal informed the member of the Governing Council that four non-teaching staff Class III employee of our college are working against management post. These services can be regularized against vacant position on account of retirement of non-teaching staff. Their names are as follows:
