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A meeting of the Governing Body of Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad, was held on 8th January 2026 at 11:30 AM at the Women's Wing Campus. The meeting was chaired by the President of the Governing Body, Sardar R.S. Chahal and following members were present:

Proceedings:

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting held on 3rd November 2025 were read and confirmed unanimously by the members present.
2. The Council reviewed the progress of several pending initiatives from the prior session:

The Council was informed that two trainers - one male and one female, both of whom are students at the college - have been identified to support the gym's operations. The Council suggested that the Principal take immediate steps to make the facility operational for students at the earliest.

Members emphasized the importance of academic resources and insisted on the swift completion of the purchase of the remaining books required for the library.

An update was provided regarding ongoing technical upgrades, including the installation and setup of CCTV cameras and enhanced storage capacity. Additionally, the Council noted that the procurement of new computers and the repair of existing units are currently in progress and expected to be finalized shortly.

The Council was also apprised that the official college website is currently undergoing a comprehensive upgrade to improve its functionality and interface.

3. The Council deliberated on the detailed plans for the upcoming Republic Day celebrations scheduled for January 26th. It was unanimously decided to reintroduce the practice of felicitating meritorious students for their achievements in Curricular, Co-Curricular, and Extra-Curricular activities on this day. This tradition, which had been discontinued over the past three years, will once again be a central part of the celebration.

The Cultural Committee was tasked with organizing a parade, a short patriotic program along with the felicitation ceremony involving students, volunteers and cadets.

4. The Governing Council carefully reviewed the formal letters submitted by Mr. Chiranjeet Adhikari and Ms. Anuradha Kumari, both of whom expressed a strong interest in rejoining the institution.

The Council noted Mr. Adhikari's previous 5.5-year tenure as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Commerce. His representation highlighted that while his departure in January 2024 was due to professional pressures at the time, he is now optimistic about the college's current leadership and collaborative culture.

The Council discussed the letter from Mrs. Anuradha Kumari, who served as an Assistant Professor in the Psychology Department from September 2019 until her resignation in December 2024. She noted that changing circumstances at the college have encouraged her to seek re-employment, expressing a desire to contribute to the institution's academic progress with renewed enthusiasm.

Following a thorough discussion regarding their past service and the current requirements of their respective departments, the Council unanimously accepted their requests for re-engagement. The Principal was officially authorized to communicate this decision to both candidates and to initiate the necessary administrative procedures to facilitate their joining.

5. The Governing Council addressed the matter regarding the lease rent for the Vocational Block. After a preliminary discussion, the members determined that a more comprehensive review of the historical lease agreements and payment records was required to resolve the issue effectively.

There being no other matters to discuss, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
